Please note: Due to the dietary concerns of some of our members, our communion bread is gluten-free.

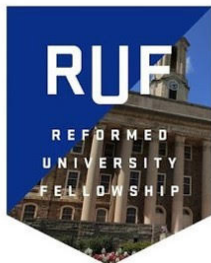
